Position Description – Director of Coaching

Objective

- To provide coaching expertise and professional support to St Peters Football Club

Responsibilities

- Ensure with collaboration of VP Operations and head of operations all coaches are appointed and accredited with WWC checks following interviewing and vetting process
- Provide skill training for coaches
- Provide coaches with training drill/game day information via regular email correspondence
- Review and provide mark ups for the Coaches Manual
- Attend and run Open day
- Arrange and implement initial coach information night– initial information session
- Assistance with grading teams (U12 mixed and above)
- One on one feedback to coaches – including written feedback on each coach two times during the season. May then provide higher focus for coaches that require additional assistance.
- Attend training and game day to evaluate coaching techniques and support improvement
- Conduct coach update evenings to provide professional development
- Provide workshops for players for skill development football fundamentals program and info sessions
- Implement surveys during the season and post season to support improvement in our processes and coach skill development/education in collaboration with head of operations
- Provide report for AGM
- Provide structure about what's required

Relationships

- Works in collaboration with the VP football operations , age group coordinators
- Builds strong relationships with other clubs Directors of coaching, head of operations
- Builds strong relationships with SMJFL and AFL and Auskick program

Accountability
